Two sets of plans must be submitted before permit will be issued.  
 Appointments for inspections must be made in advance and will be scheduled as soon as possible.  
 All inspections require a representative to be on site to test system with electrical inspector.

## **Fire Alarm Permit Application Inspection Protocol:**

### **Permit** –

When applying for a fire alarm permit you will have to forward (3) sets of plans to the Fire Safety Consultants, Inc. for review (contact them prior to sending the plans). You may obtain the permit from the Building Department at any time but no inspection will be scheduled until all plans are approved by the consultant.

When the plans have been approved and the consultant has informed the Building and Fire Department, you may call to schedule an inspection at (586) 992-0710 and we will meet you on the job site for the inspection.

### **Inspection(s)** –

For duct detectors, a representative will have to be present at the time of the inspection and will be required to provide manufacturer testing procedures for duct detectors. If the procedures are not provided at the time of inspection, the inspection will be rejected and a reinspection fee will be due.

For sprinkler flow test, you will need to have fire alarm notification system ready to call dispatch. During testing we will need the fire alarm system to be put in and out of test mode.
