THE FOREVER WAR: THE ENDLESS FIGHT TO PROVIDE VALUE FOR YOUR TAXES BY TREASURER LEON DROLET

Rattlesnakes, Flying Bats and a New Sidewalk

Fighting to keep your taxes low while providing top quality public safety and improving roads, sidewalks and sewers is an endless battle. Obstacles to government efficiency include expensive state and federal mandates, inflation, and Washington D.C. and Lansing redistributing your state and federal tax dollars to other municipalities.

The Macomb Township Board aggressively applies for grants to bring back as much of your state and federal tax dollars as possible. But unexpected strings attached to some grants demonstrate how loony the federal bureaucracy in Washington can be.

One example of federal mandates driving up costs is a new sidewalk along 25 Mile Road connecting Corners Park to the Township's Recreation Center on Broughton Rd. The Township applied for a grant to pay for the sidewalk and was pleased to be awarded \$250,000. We had brought some federal tax dollars back to the Township! But guess what the feds mandated we do for that sidewalk money?

- Pay for a study to ensure the sidewalk would not negatively impact any population of 'Indiana Bats' (a regional bat species).
- Pay for a certification that the project would not impact reproduction of Mississauga Rattlesnakes (a native snake species).
- Pay an archaeologist to certify the sidewalk would not disturb native American burial grounds or archeological sites.
- Get approval from the U.S. Department of

Agriculture because the sidewalk crosses federally designated 'prime agricultural land'.

- Pay workers building the sidewalk an extremely costly wage under the federal Davis-Bacon Act.

Ouch! While the grant paid for a valuable new sidewalk, the process demonstrated how bureaucratic excess drives up costs. I understand being sensitive to wildlife habitat, but these one-size-fits-all mandates really weren't appropriate for this project. Big government mandates aren't just associated with grants - they intrude into every aspect of providing local services. Some mandates are justified to improve public safety, transparency, or the environment but too many are just burdensome and intrusive. The Board wants to bring as much of your taxes back to your community as possible. We greatly appreciate the state representatives and senators and U.S. representatives who represent Macomb Township for being allies and working with us to cut through bureaucracy and bring tax dollars home. In the past four years the Board has secured millions more in road dollars than at any other time in Township history.

The battle against government waste never ends and your Township Board embraces our mission to bring you the best value possible. Our goal is not to build the government, but to support you and your family as efficiently as possible.

ENHANCING ENJOYMENT FOR ALL AT WALDENBURG PARK!



Macomb Township's Waldenburg Park is getting a much-needed facelift this year, with significant upgrades planned to make this community hub even better! Thanks to careful planning and thoughtful investment, the Township has committed to repairing, enhancing and modernizing key features in the park, ensuring it remains a welcoming space for residents of all ages and abilities.

Improving Connectivity and Appeal

This year, the park's network of bridges received some needed restorations to enhance the safety and appeal of the park paths. The bridges, which serve as links connecting the scenic pathways through the wooded areas to the pavilions, have been meticulously upgraded. The process involved carefully removing the side rails to undergo cleaning and restoration before being reinstalled. Additionally, new wood pieces were fitted to replace the original decking, providing enhanced safety for park visitors and a refreshed look to the bridges themselves. This bridge restoration project not only improves the park's functionality but also contributes to the overall harmonious blend of nature and design that

Paving the Way for Inclusive Play

Perhaps the most exciting transformation coming to Waldenburg Park is the replacement of the existing playground equipment. Recognizing the importance of enrichment and interaction for children of all physical abilities, the Township is installing a boundless playground structure designed to provide play opportunities for all children regardless of abilities.

The new equipment incorporates a variety of features, with 84% of play activities specifically designed to accommodate children with physical disabilities. This ensures that children who use wheelchairs, walkers or other mobility aids can participate fully in the fun!

"The Parks and Recreation Department is thrilled to be adding a boundless playground at Waldenburg Park. Providing more inclusive play for everyone is always a goal of our department," said Macomb Township Parks and Recreation Department Director Sal DiCaro. "We look forward to offering a playground that can be used by as many as children as possible."

Strategic Investment in the Community

Funding for this exciting project was made possible through a strategic reallocation of resources. In 2024, Macomb Township received \$3 million in state funding to address road infrastructure improvements. Receiving this funding allowed the Township to redirect previously earmarked funds toward the playground

project, creating two substantial improvement projects in the Township to improve the quality of life of our residents.

With a unanimous vote, the Township Board approved an investment of just under \$727,000 for the new equipment. The move underscores the Township's commitment to inclusivity and community well-being.

"The Board of Trustees remains committed to creating inclusive spaces where all our residents can connect with one another," said Macomb Township Supervisor Viviano. "Approving the new boundless playground equipment is just one of the many ways we hope to create opportunities for our residents to come together and strengthen our community."

Anticipation Builds for Spring

Once the cold months break into warmer weather, the installation of the new structure will begin. MTPR anticipates the installation to be completed by May 2025, just in time for families to enjoy it as warmer weather arrives.

"These upgrades are about more than just maintenance—they're about building a space where everyone in Macomb Township feels included and valued. Regardless of your activity of choice, this park is for you," Viviano said.

SOLICITING IN MACOMB TOWNSHIP: A MESSAGE FROM CLERK POZZI

Soliciting in the Township is regulated to ensure the safety and privacy of residents while allowing businesses and organizations to engage with the community in an orderly manner. Whether you are a resident, business representative, nonprofit organization, or an individual looking to solicit, it is crucial to understand the rules and requirements set forth by local ordinances.

Permit Requirements

Most forms of solicitation require a permit from the Township. Individuals or businesses planning to solicit must apply for a permit through the Township Planning Department. The application process typically includes:

- Completing a permit application form
- Paying an application fee
- Undergoing a background check, if applicable

Nonprofit organizations, such as religious groups or charities, and political canvassing may be exempt from certain permit fees but are still encouraged to register with the Township before soliciting.

Hours and Restrictions

To prevent disturbances, the Township enforces specific hours during which solicitation is allowed. Soliciting may be conducted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. EST.

Behavior and Conduct Guidelines

Solicitors are expected to follow a code of conduct, which includes:

- Identifying themselves and their organization when approaching residents, which includes wearing the issued ID badge and ensuring it is always visible.
- Refraining from aggressive, deceptive, or intrusive tactics
- Refraining from soliciting where "No Soliciting" signs are posted
- Leaving premises promptly if asked
- Providing residents with a contact number for verification if soliciting on behalf of a company or charity

Enforcement

Failure to comply with Township solicitation rules can result in penalties such as:

- Removed from the area by local Sheriffs for unlicensed solicitation
- Revocation of an existing solicitation permit

Residents can verify solicitors that have current permits by visiting Macomb-mi.org / Planning Department / Approved Solicitor List. If you experience issues with solicitors, you can report violations to the Planning Department or contact the Sheriff's Office.

Understanding and following solicitation rules in the Township is essential for maintaining a respectful and safe community environment.

MTRC Rules & Policies

- Photo I.D. required every visit.
- 10 years and under must be directly supervised by an adult.
- 11 years to 9th grade must have an adult parent in the facility, but not directly supervised.
- 9th grade+ can be unsupervised, must provide I.D. every visit.

Rec Center AGE RESTRICTION AREAS:

Cardio & Free Weight Centers

You must be currently in 9th grade, with valid High School I.D., to use the Cardio and Free Weight Centers.

Running/Walking Track

Children in the 8th grade and younger must always have a legal guardian (21+) with them when using the track.

Daily Admission Pass (Children ages 3 and under are free with a paying adult)

Dress Code Policy

Recreation Center

- Patrons are required to wear appropriate athletic attire.
- All sleeveless shirts must not exceed 2" below armpit.
- All athletic tops must be worn 3" from the belly button.
- Bare midribs or otherwise revealing clothing are not permitted.

Aquatics Center

- Appropriate swimming attire (i.e., swimsuit, swim trunks) is required in the pool (at the discretion of staff) – no street clothes, cut-off shorts, athletic apparel, etc.
- Children permitted in swim diapers or securely fitted rubber pants ONLY. Diaper changes should occur in the restroom. Diapers should be disposed of in the restroom trash.


