# UPCOMING EVENTS & IMPORTANT DATES

## 24 MILE ROAD TRAFFIC DELAYS

Beginning February 2025 through July 2025, Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) will be making repairs on the 36" water main along 24 Mile Road from the City of Rochester to Fairchild Road in Macomb Township.



- Repairs along **24 Mile Road from the City of Rochester to Romeo Plank Road** will take place between **February and April 2025**.
- Repairs along **24 Mile Road between Romeo Plank Road and Fairchild Road** will take place between **May and July 2025**.

***Anticipate traffic delays on 24 Mile Road during this timeframe.***

## WINTER TAX BILL PAYMENTS

Winter tax bill payments are **due to the Macomb Township Treasurer's Office by Friday, February 14, 2025**. Payments can be made in person with cash, check or credit/debit at the Treasurer's Office. You can also pay online through the Township's Online Payment Service.

A secure drop box is also available for your convenience on a 24-hour basis at the top of the ramp entering the rear of Township Hall. A secure drive-up drop box is also located in the west parking lot of Township Hall for all payments by check. **No cash in the drop boxes please.**
