Township-wide street lighting project for LED upgrades underway

Thanks to a Carbon Reduction grant from SEMCOG, in coordination with the Macomb County Department of Roads and the Michigan Department of Transportation, DTE Energy is in the process of upgrading all high-pressure sodium and mercury vapor lamps on streetlights in residential developments to LED lights. The project will be running through the end of March 2025. **We ask that residents avoid parking in front of streetlights, whenever possible, during this time period.
