Township welcomes new full-time firefighter and celebrates positive community quality report

Macomb Township, Mich. – Macomb Township has remained steadfast in its commitment to delivering the highest quality services to residents, and our emergency services is the latest example. During the Wednesday, July 24, Board of Trustee meeting, the Board approved the hire of an additional full-time firefighter to the Macomb Township Fire Department.

Firefighter Ron Tremonti has dedicated 15 years of service to the community as a paid-on-call firefighter, and we are thrilled to welcome him to the full-time ranks. Notably, this new hire has been accomplished without any increase in cost to residents, ensuring no additional tax burden.

“We’re happy to have Firefighter Tremonti joining us as a full-time firefighter and know his experience will serve the community well,” said Macomb Township Fire Chief Bob Phillips.

The Board meeting also featured a presentation by Kolby Miller, CEO and President of Medstar, the Township’s contracted EMT/Paramedic service. Miller presented the 2023 Community Quality Report, which highlights the exceptional emergency and non-emergency medical services provided to our residents.

Key findings from the report showed that Medstar received a total of 6,320 calls in 2023, 2,797 of which were non-emergency calls and 3,523 were emergency calls. Additionally, Medstar’s highly skilled EMTs and Paramedics have a fast emergency response time of just over 5 minutes, and an average of 6 minutes and 45 seconds for non-emergency responses.

To top off the presentation, Macomb Township residents were surveyed about their experiences with Medstar’s services, and they received a 97.2% top box satisfaction rate for Macomb Township patients. The Macomb Township Fire Department and Medstar make a great pair to provide outstanding medical services to our community.

“Safety is one of the most important things we focus on here in Macomb Township, and we commend the Fire Department and Medstar for providing outstanding services to our residents in critical situations.” said Macomb Township Supervisor Viviano.
