Multiple Road Improvement Projects Advance in Macomb Township

Macomb Township, Mich. – Macomb Township is making significant strides in improving local infrastructure, with several key road projects either underway or in the planning stages. These initiatives aim to improve the flow of traffic, increase safety, and support the growing needs of our community.

During the September 11 Board of Trustees meeting, the board voted to authorize Township Supervisor Frank Viviano to sign a Macomb County resolution supporting the resurfacing of Hayes Road from 23 Mile Road to 25 Mile Road. This resolution serves as a letter of intent, confirming Macomb Township's commitment to contribute funding toward this vital road improvement project.

"Macomb Township is excited about the opportunity to partner with Shelby Township and Macomb County Department of Roads to resurface the section of Hayes Road from 23 to 25 Mile Roads," said Macomb Township Land Development Director Jim Van Tiflin. "Anyone who has driven this section of Hayes Road can attest that it desperately needs to be fixed. With Garfield Road being completed, we're in a better position to have this work done."

The Township is also thrilled to see progress being made on several other significant road projects.

"The various road projects currently underway reflect our ongoing commitment to improving Macomb Township's infrastructure," said Viviano. "We're dedicated to enhancing safety, reducing congestion, and supporting our community's growth through these vital improvements."

Phase II Garfield Road Extension: Phase II of the Garfield Road Extension from 23 Mile to 25 Mile is nearing completing and is expected to open to traffic in the coming weeks.

Romeo Plank Road Widening: Plans are in place for the widening of Romeo Plank Road to enhance the traffic capacity of the area and construct a safer intersection at 22 Mile Road. This project is anticipated to being in 2025.

Broughton Road Extension: The long-anticipated project continues to progress, and the Township is excited to see the early stages of a connected Town Center come to life.

21 Mile and Heydenreich Road Intersection: Early-stage plans are underway to improve the intersection of 21 Mile Road and Heydenreich Road, with a focus on enhancing pedestrian safety, particularly for students traveling to and from nearby schools.
