Township presented with \$2.6 million Transportation Alternatives Program grant

Your Township Board of Trustees was thrilled to accept a \$2.6 million grant from the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) through their Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). Projects funded through a TAP grant improve roadways and corridors by adding or enhancing multi-modal infrastructure such as bike lanes and sidewalks. These funds will be used to develop a pedestrian-friendly boulevard along the future Broughton Road extension.


Help keep yourself and your neighbors safe this winter!

With the snowy winter weather we're seeing, we would like to remind property owners in Macomb Township of the Snow & Ice Removal Ordinance. Property owners are required to remove snow and/or ice from public sidewalks within 24 hours of a snow and/or ice event. This applies to public sidewalks on all sides of a home or business, including those that run along major roads and connector roads. Removing snow and ice in a timely manner helps keep ourselves and our neighbors safe from potential slips and falls.
