Macomb Township Recreation Center:

The Macomb Township Recreation Center opened its doors on July 19, 2004. This state of the art 90,000 square foot facility offers 2 pools (with water slide, a lazy river and other water features), a gymnasium, aerobics room, complete workout area, running track, soft play indoor playscape, child watch room, teen room and a party room. On June 18, 2007 the Recreation Center opened its phase II expansion which includes a second gymnasium, improved and expanded workout facilities, an improved figure eight running track, an additional party room and more! The Recreation Center will be the hub of recreational activity for Macomb Township residents for many years to come. If you haven't already, come visit us soon and see what we have to offer for family members of all ages.

Parks and Recreation Programs

The Parks and Recreation Department also offers a variety of recreational programs, including sports, fitness, seasonal events, summer camps, senior activities, sporting events, theater trips, and more. The R.E.A.C.H.(Recreation, Events, Activities and Center Happenings) catalog is mailed to all Macomb Township homes three times a year: Winter, Spring /Summer and Fall. It has all available Parks and Recreation activities, Recreation Center information and events, plus updates about our parks and community events. Online / web registration is available for select classes. This catalog is also available [on our website](#).

Township Parks

- **Waldenburg Park:** Waldenburg Park is a developed park approximately 17 acres in size located on 21 Mile Road about ½ mile east of Romeo Plank Road. It offers a children's play area, picnic pavilions, basketball court, 2 sand volleyball courts, restrooms and a walking trail.
- **Macomb Corners Park:** Macomb Township's newest addition of parkland, Macomb Corners Park, opened in the summer of 2004. It is a 94 acre (35 developed) park site located on the north side of 25 Mile Road just east of Luchtman Road. The amenities of the park will include 2 soccer fields, 2 football fields, 3 lighted ball diamonds, inline skating rink, playscape, picnic pavilions and a rest room/concession building. The park will be both an active park hosting sporting events, and an inviting location for family activities.
- **Macomb Town Center Park:** Macomb Town Center Park is a 15 acre park located on the south side of 25 Mile Road just west of Broughton Road. It is used for many community events, including summer concerts, Movie Under the Stars, children's activities, sports camps and athletic events.

ASSESSING DEPARTMENT - Contact them for questions regarding:

Parcel info, legal descriptions, value, transfers, ownership of property; exemptions; land divisions

*The Assessing Department is responsible for identifying and valuing all taxable real and personal property within the Township of Macomb in accordance with Michigan's General Property Tax Laws. Macomb Township has approximately 29,000 real property parcels and 750 personal property parcels. Due to the changes in property tax laws, one or more forms are required to be filed with the Assessor's Office when property transfers ownership. **These forms are available on our website.***

BOARD OF REVIEW: Taxpayers may dispute their Assessed and/or Taxable Values before the Board of Review. The Board of Review meets each year, beginning the second Monday in March for a minimum of three days. This is the one and only opportunity each year, which taxpayers may protest. Protests are heard for the current year only. Every taxpayer will receive an Assessment Notice by approximately March 1st, each year. This notice will include the dates and times, which the Board of Review will be meeting. Hearings are held by appointment only.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT – Contact them for questions regarding:

Obtaining permits for: wood burning stoves, fireplace inserts, decks, sheds, pools, construction additions, fences, additional electrical, plumbing, heating systems and air conditioners; ordinance violations, scheduling inspections; sidewalk repair concerns; abandoned / unkempt properties; Certificates of Zoning;

*The Building Department is responsible for inspecting any construction that a permit is taken out for in Macomb Township. This includes any building, plumbing, heating, or electrical work that is done in Macomb Township. If you are unsure that a permit has been taken out or if a permit is required, please contact us. **Most of these requirements, forms and applications can be downloaded from our website.***

TREASURER'S DEPARTMENT– Contact them for questions regarding:

Tax due dates, rate structure, payment options; escrow accounts; liens; payment of water & sewerage bills

The Treasurer's office is solely responsible for the receipt, deposit, control and disbursement of all receipts (taxes and all other revenues) of the Township on a daily basis. The Treasurer collects taxes for all taxing units within the Township, such as the Chippewa Valley, L'Anse Creuse, Utica, and New Haven Schools. An important function of the Treasurer's office involves the investment of available Township funds. Responsible and conservative investment policies insure maximum return with minimal risk. The office also bills, collects, and maintains all Township Special Assessments for water, sewer and pavement. Winter and Summer taxes can be paid at the Township Offices at 54111 Broughton Road.

MACOMB TOWNSHIP HISTORY

By the early 1830's, people began settling in the area now known as Macomb Township. Officially, the Township of Macomb, was erected under the authority of the Legislative Council, and approved on March 7, 1834. The flat land and fertile soil brought in by the Clinton River attracted many German farmers, and even now, Macomb Township retains many of its German influences.

One of the first people to settle in Macomb Township was Daniel Kniffens who acquired land on the Middle Branch of the Clinton River. This area was commonly known as the Village of Macomb Corners and is near the corner of present day 25 Mile and Romeo Plank Roads.

Macomb Township is now on the cutting edge of urban growth with population in excess of 88,000.

Macomb Township is located in the center of Macomb County and the heart of the world. It is one of the fastest growing communities in Macomb County and in the State of Michigan. We offer a good industrial /commercial corridor for growth, carefully balanced with our beautiful residential neighborhoods and wonderful parks. As a progressive community, we welcome you and look forward to serving you and your family.



Getting a library card

To get a library card, please bring proof of residency in Clinton Township or Macomb Township. This includes a current photo ID and proof of street address, such as a Michigan driver's license or a state ID card. If you do not have a license or ID card, you can get a library card with two other acceptable forms of proof of residency including: a current lease agreement, tax bill, tax receipt, current school photo ID with current address or proof of local employment. If you are not a resident of Clinton or Macomb Township you will need to have a library card from the library located in your home city. Simply fill out our library card application online or at any CMPL location to receive your library card.


