## **Assessing Department**

The Assessing Department is responsible for identifying and valuing all taxable real and personal property within the Township. Taxpayers may dispute their Assessed and/or Taxable Values before the Board of Review. The Board of Review meets each year, beginning the second Monday in March for a minimum of three days. Every taxpayer will receive an Assessment Notice by approximately March 1st, each year. This notice will include dates, and times, which the Board of Review will be meeting. Hearings are held by appointment only.

# Watering Basics

---

## **WHY DOES MACOMB TOWNSHIP HAVE AN OUTDOOR WATERING ORDINANCE?**

On May 13, 2009, the Macomb Township Board passed Ordinance No. 242 which puts limitations on water use. "Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances for The Township of Macomb is hereby amended and revised for the purposes of protecting the public health, safety, and welfare; providing for decreases in maximum water usage at peak hours in order to achieve a better water rate from the GLWA; provide for a decrease in peak water usage in order to provide for better water pressure throughout the entire system during peak flows in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare."

## **HOW IS THE ORDINANCE ENFORCED?**

The Macomb Township Water & Sewer Department will be taking a more aggressive approach to enforce the Outdoor Watering Ordinance. Violators will be given a notice of the violation with the following posted on their door.

## **WHAT IS PEAK WATER USAGE?**

The Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) monitors each community's water usage during peak periods. The peak period for all communities is from 6 AM to Midnight EDT daily. The highest amount of water used during this time period equals a community's Peak Usage.

## **MACOMB TOWNSHIP'S PEAK USAGE HABITS:**

Macomb Township has continued to have a higher water demand during peak periods, especially due to automated irrigation systems. The consequence of not shifting heavy use from automated irrigation systems to NON-PEAK HOURS (Midnight to 6 AM EDT) is a higher water supply charge incurred to the Township from GLWA.

## **HOW CAN MACOMB TOWNSHIP MANAGE WATER RATES?**

The only way to manage the rates charged from GLWA is to shift the heavy water use to non-peak hours which are midnight to 6 AM EDT.



# Medical Marijuana Ordinance

## **CAREGIVER GROWING BANNED IN MACOMB TOWNSHIP NEIGHBORHOODS**

Your Macomb Township Board of Trustees has made protecting the integrity of our community a top priority.

Effective April 14th, 2021, the Macomb Township Medical Marijuana Ordinance prohibits the ability of caregivers to grow in a residential neighborhood. Growing marijuana in any residentially zoned property is only allowable for personal or medical use, capped at 12 plants and 100 square feet of space.

Anyone who wished to grow Medical Marijuana, must register with the Township and follow strict guidelines contained in the Macomb Township Medical Marijuana Ordinance.

Additionally, our Fire Marshall has issued a Fire Bulletin that prohibits electricity consumption over what is safe for a residential building. This includes limiting homes to one air conditioner except in certain circumstances subject to approval by the Township.

Macomb Township actively enforces this ordinance. Violators risk jail, fines, seizure and forfeiture of property, loss of electrical service, etc.

Richmond Lenox E.M.S. provides door to door transit for area residents needing transportation to and from medical appointments/procedures, banking, nutritional trips, or for work, personal business and to Detroit Metro Airport. Our staff is trained in First Aid and CPR and will assist riders from their door to the vehicle and transport them safely to their destination. While there is no charge for our service, we do accept donations. Rides may be scheduled up to six weeks beforehand, and whenever possible with 72 hours advance notice. Transportation is provided on a first come first serve basis. Our service operates much like a public transit system and may involve picking up multiple riders going in the same direction near the same time. This type of routing provides us the necessary economies of scale to serve the greatest number of residents. This service model also necessitates riders remaining flexible when utilizing our service.

The Macomb Township Recreation Center is a 92,000 square foot facility providing both residents and non-residents with a wide array of recreational activities and amenities. The state of the art Recreation Center facilitates a fitness center, 2 gymnasiums, 3 birthday party rooms, 2 aerobics rooms, an indoor playground, meeting space, a feature pool, an activity pool, a lazy river, water slide and a hot tub. The Recreation Center staff prides itself in providing a safe, clean, family-friendly environment. The Recreation Center is visited by several hundred people daily and several hundred thousand people per year.

The Macomb Township Recreation Center also acts as the headquarters for Macomb Township Parks and Recreation Department and is the host of several special events held throughout the year.

An active membership or daily admission pass is required for both Macomb Township residents and non-residents to enter the facility and use its amenities. There are several membership options to choose from; such as monthly and annual memberships, along with trial and summer memberships.
